

City of Hart Tax Increment Finance Authority 2021 Annual Synopsis

Synopsis Overview

Under Public Act 57 of 2018, TIFA is required to place an Annual Synopsis of the activities of the City of Hart TIFA. These "Annual Synopsis" will be uploaded to the City of Hart's website 180 days after the end of the prior Fiscal Year.

Public Meetings

Under Public Act 57 of 2018, the City of Hart TIFA is required to hold two public meetings each year for the purpose of informing the public of the goals and direction of the authority, including projects to be undertaken in the coming year. The first public meeting was held at the Hart City Council meeting on November 9, 2021 and the second public meeting was as part of the Hart Tax Increment Finance Authority meeting on December 9, 2021. Notices of these public meetings were sent to the City or Hart Clerk, Oceana County Clerk, Oceana County Administrator, Council on Aging, 911, Veterans, and Hart Cemetery.

Tax Increment Revenues not spent within 5 years

The City of Hart Tax Increment Finance Authority does not have any tax increment revenues meeting these criteria. Under Public Act 57 of 2019, any such revenues not spent within 5 years would need to be discussed in this section. Although our TIFA does have a fund balance, it does not include funds that are 5 years old. The fund balance is dedicated by resolution against future projects. The amount of the current fund balance and a copy of the resolution dedicating these funds against future projects can be found in the TIFA Budgets on the Tax Increment Finance Authority page of the City of Hart website (www.cityofhart.org).

TIFA Accomplishments

In recent years our TIFA has accomplished many projects that have allowed us to make progress on our TIFA Plans and various amendments.

- Authorized hiring of a Community Events Coordinator for one year to be re-assessed in December 2022
- Purchased a tension shade canopy to provide shade/shelter for performers at Hart Commons
- Partnered with the Hart Economic and Redevelopment Team to create a citywide Wayfinding
 Design Project using Valley Sign to create a design proposal that met the goals of the TIFA
 Plan by providing consistency in terminology and graphics showcasing Hart's attractions in a
 consistent manner.
- Annual contribution towards Pocket Park maintenance
- Supported development of Pocket Park

- Supported three businesses in the district with façade improvements through the Property Improvement Grant Program established in 2020 offering a 50% improvement match
- Gained administrative support from Hart Economic & Community Development Director in 2020
- Streetscape lighting down State Street and other major corridors
- Non-vehicular traffic improvements (sidewalk repair & maintenance)
- Installed cross-road banner poles that allow community events held within the TIFA District to be advertised on banners hung across Main Street.
- Courtland Street rebuild
- Dryden Street rebuild & extension
- Support of Hart Commons Park Development
- Assisted library with relocation
- Public restroom facility for the downtown district

TIFA Projects and Investments

Through public private partnerships, TIFA has invested in commercial buildings through TIFA's Property Improvement Program. This program offers a 50% matching grant to businesses interested in doing exterior repairs or alterations to their storefronts. This program is available to all commercial properties within the Tax Increment Finance Authority district.

Below are the investments made through TIFA's Property Improvement Program since it began in 2020. A total of \$27,806 dollars were awarded as property improvement grants, spurring a total of \$55,839 in private investment.
